

University of Illinois Collegiate Mountain Bike XC Race Saturday, August 26th 2006

EVENT DESCRIPTION

Course: The University of Illinois cycling club will be hosting a XC race on the mountain bike trails of Kickapoo State Park. The course is relatively fast and has a lot to offer. It has a good mix of single track, a few technical sections, and some short climbs coupled with short downhill sections. <u>Women B</u>	9:15am	~ 10 miles	1 lap
<u>Men B</u>	10:30am	~ 20 miles	2 laps
<u>Women A</u>	10:45am	~ 20 miles	2 laps
<u>Men A</u>	1:00pm	~ 30 miles	3 laps

Registration: * Registration will end 15 minutes prior to each event*****

- Registration will open at 8:00am
- All riders must present a valid student ID in order to race
- All riders must have a valid collegiate license or purchase a day license at the race
- Entry fee is \$12 per rider (Checks made payable to IBRC)

EVENT LOCATION

Location: Kickapoo State Park is located 5 miles west of Danville, Illinois and 30 miles east of Champaign, Illinois. Take Oakwood exit #206 off Interstate 74. Turn north and follow signs to Kickapoo State Park. Once in the park, follow the mountain bike trail signs to the trailhead parking lot, which is 1.2 miles north of the park office. The Trail Head is very easy to spot from the road, and a good strip map can be found at: <http://kickapoombc.org/directions.php>

Lodging: The closest hotels are located in Danville, IL and should only be a 10-15 minute drive away. Camping is also available at Kickapoo State Park, but only in designated areas, which does NOT include the Trail Head.
