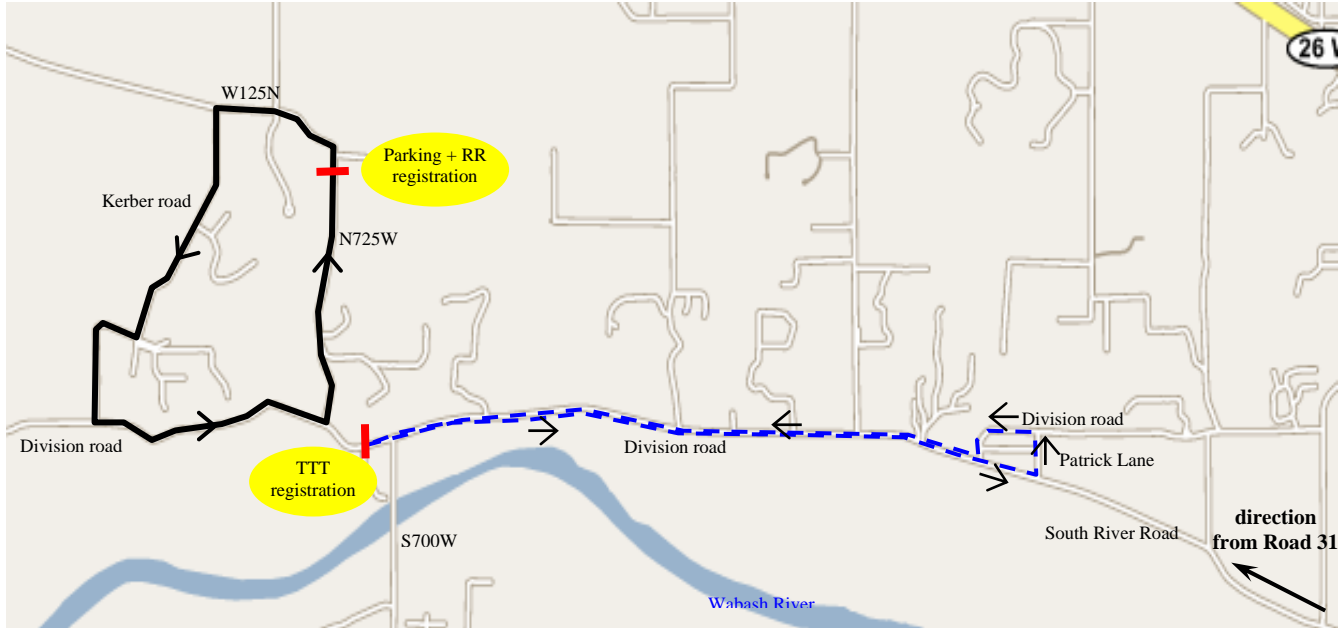


PURDUE UNIVERSITY TTT AND ROAD RACE

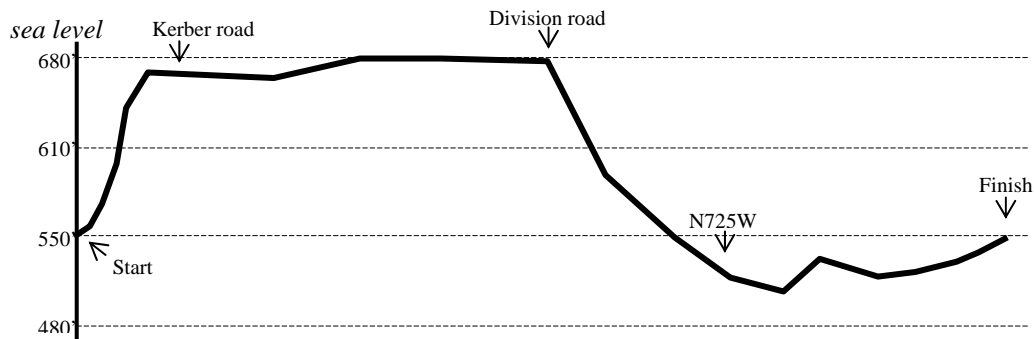
Sunday, April 15, 2007

Directions

From I65, take state road 26 West through Lafayette across the bridge. In West Lafayette, take left on Road 231. At the first traffic light south of the industrial zone turn right and then left to go on South River Road. Continue on this road for ~10 miles (South River Road becomes Division Road) to access the TTT start site. Parking will be possible at Martell Forest, 1011 North 725, West Lafayette, IN (indicated on the map). The road race will start and finish on N725W ~1 mile from the TTT start/finish line.

Schedule (*registrations open 1h before each event close to the start/finish lines; races held rain or shine*)

Team Time Trial (6 miles): entry fee of \$20 per team, and please complete the registration sheet on page 3, and sign one Purdue waiver (see page 5) per rider.

For the TTT teams will start every minute. A gap of 5 minutes will be observed after women teams.

NCCA specific rules:

- 1- Teams shall be made up of two to four riders. A minimum of two riders is needed for women, and three riders for men teams (new rule for 2007);
 - 2- The time for the team is taken when the front wheel of the second (women) or third (men) rider crossing the finish line;
 - 3- Only women may compete in the women's Team Time Trial. A men's Team Time Trial squad may be composed of both men and women (women A can compete only with men A or B);
 - 4- If a team is caught by another, the overtaken team must stay at minimum 80 feet behind the overtaking team;
 - 5- Points awarded will be as stated in NCCA rule 5.3.10
 - 6- The team time trial points count only toward the team standings;
 - 7- A maximum number of one team from each school may score points in each category.
- Additional placed teams displace other competitors.

Waiver, Release And Hold Harmless Agreement
