Course Description:

An 8 mile, counter-clockwise loop with several short, hard climbs. The course winds through a quiet residential area on excellent pavement. The course will be open to traffic, and the yellow line rule will be in effect. This event will be held at Heritage Lake, using the continuous loop of Heritage Drive. Registration will be at the Floyd Township Fire Station. Parking and the start will be at the Fire Station located on the Southwest corner of the lake. There is additional parking at the Marina also located on the Southwest corner of the lake. **USE CAUTION WHEN DRIVING ON THE COURSE.** The finish will be near the fire station. <http://www.heritagelakepoa.com>

Course is located at Heritage Lake, Indiana:

Course is south of US 36 near Groveland, IN. **From US 36 at Groveland**, turn south on CR 725 E. At CR 600 N turn left (east) to Heritage Drive, turn right (south) on Heritage Drive to the Fire House located on the south-west corner of the lake.

There is ample parking at the facility. All USCF rules apply. Race held rain or shine. All collegiate riders must be licensed or pay one-day fee.

Course Description:

A 5 mile out and back course with one turnaround. Road is mostly smooth. The course will be open to traffic, and the yellow line rule will be in effect. This event will held on CR 100 N just east of Fillmore, IN. Parking and the start will be at the Dixie Chopper factory on CR 100 N, also east of Fillmore.

Course is located at Fillmore, Indiana:

From Hwy 75 at Coatesville, turn west on Hendricks County Road 600 S which becomes Putnam County Road 100 N. Continue to the Dixie Chopper Factory. From Fillmore, travel east on Putnam CR 100 N.

There is ample parking at the facility. **NO PARKING ON CR 100 N!!!** All USCF rules apply. Race held rain or shine. All collegiate riders must be licensed or pay one-day fee.
