

Purdue Cycling Club Road Race and TTT Saturday April 4, 2009

USAC Permit: 2009-435

Team Time Trial (10 miles): Entry fee of \$20 per team. Each entrant need to sign a Purdue University release form. Registration opens at 8:30, closes at 9:45. Points awarded per USAC rules. The course starts near Ross Hills Park, then goes and completes the out and back course (see race bible). Teams will start every minute. Schedule:

The Purdue Men's D team will go off at 10:00 AM

Men D: 10:00 (With Purdue first)

Men C: 10:15

Women B/C: 10:30

Women A: 10:40

Men B: 10:50

Men A: 11:05 (With Purdue being last)

Road Race (4 miles/lap): Entry fee of \$13 per rider. Each entrant needs to sign a Purdue University release form (not needed if done for the TTT). Points awarded per USAC rules. Same course as in 2008 (see race bible). Race will be neutralized from Ross Hill Park until just after the first turn off Division Road (referred to as "Km 0"- see bible). The finish will be on top of the hill (~mile 2.5 on the map). Each pack will be led by a Sheriff car and followed by a ref car. Schedule:

Women B/C	12:01 PM	4 laps/18 Mi.
Men C	1:15 PM	6 laps/26 Mi.
Women A	1:16 PM	5 laps/22 Mi.
Men A	3:15 PM	9 laps/38 Mi.
Men B	3:16 PM	7 laps/30 Mi.

Registration

Registration opens at 8:30am, Closes 20 min before each race begins- bring signed release waiver. Registration held at Ross Hills park near the parking area.

*NCCA license required. All USAC rules apply

*One day license costs \$10

Directions/Parking: The parking is in Ross Hill Park, 8815 W50S, West Lafayette, IN. From West Lafayette, follow US Road 231 South for about 1 mile. At the traffic light, turn right, then immediately left on to South River Road. Continue on South River Road for about 10 miles (becomes Division Road after ~4 miles) and turn left on S875W (the road is the first left turn past the top of the long hill). Park in the designated parking areas and, please, respect the park regulations and do not park on the grass.
