Course Description:

Riders can expect to find one of the most fun, perhaps funnest, courses of the MWCCC season. The course is located in the heavily glaciated portion of Wisconsin known as the Northern Kettle Moraine. Approximately 15,000 years ago when the glaciers melted away their melted ice/water flows deposited all the sand and rock they had accumulated when they advanced. The resulting land forms are still with us today. The region is dotted with small up-hills, down-hills, flat-parts and lakes. Luckily for us the course is only on the up-hills, down-hills and flat-parts.

The roads are windy and depending on the wind, windy. (Think about it...) Most riders should be able to handle the hills with a 12-25 cassette, but you are not most riders.

The road surface is in good condition. All riders will be expected to ride on the right/correct side of the road. The yellow line rule will be enforced!!

There are two right-hand turns, one left and then one more right. Corners will be marshaled but please be cognizant of traffic as the roads are open to the public.

- 6 Please heed the warm-up roads designated for warming up. The "warm up" road is County T. To get there go straight out of the Old Wade House parking lot across Center road to County T. Take a right onto T. We have been asked to warm-up on these roads and not the course by the Sheboygan County Sheriffs Department who will be present to enforce the rules of the road and warm up.

2. There will be a neutral professional mechanic in the parking lot, to help you with minor issues.

From Milwaukee - Take I-43 north to Highway 57 North (Exit 97). Go North on 57 (about 27 miles) to Highway 23 West Plymouth. Go west on Hwy 23 (approx 6 miles). Turn left on County A. Turn right on Mill Street. Race parking lot will be ahead on the right. (Red Star on map)

From Madison - Take US-151 North to Fond Du Lac. Turn Right onto US-45/US-151 South. Exit US-45 following US-151 to Hwy 23 East. Go East on Hwy 23 (approx 15 miles). Turn Right onto County A. Next turn Right on Mill Street. Race parking lot will be ahead on the right. (Red Star on map)

Places to Stay:

Please consider the races start fairly early and there is around a 1.5 - 2 hour drive between courses. Also Saturday evening the Conference meeting will be held in Madison. You should look into the hotel you pick. I don't have any experience with any of these hotels.
