



Purdue Cycling Club MWCCC Mountain Bike Race

Sept. 19-20, 2009

Held under USA Cycling permit # 2432

Saturday, Sept. 19- XC at McCormick Woods

This year the XC race will be held towards the north end of Purdue's campus at McCormick woods. The course will consist of mainly flat twisty single track, with open double track near the start/finish. Approximate 5 mile lap.

Directions:

From I-65, take state Road 26 west through Lafayette, across the Wabash River into West Lafayette, and through Purdue's Campus. At the west end of Purdue's campus, turn right onto McCormick road (Road 526). After about 3/4 mile you should see the start / finish in the field to your right. Take a left into the tennis complex and park in the gravel lot.

Sunday, Sept. 20- DS and STXC on campus at Slater Hill

STXC- The short track will be on a completely redesigned course. The course goes on the Slater hill as well as the surrounding area. It has a few short climbs, drops and some somewhat technical doubletrack.

DS- The DS course will also be on Slater hill and is a traditional setup with dual lanes feeding into 1 large lane for the finishing stretch. There will not be any jumps but it will still be challenging. Down hill bikes not recommended. Start times will be posted after registration

Directions from XC course: Head southeast on IN-526/McCormick Rd for .5 miles. Turn left at W Stadium Ave. There will be a parking lot on the right. It is only a mile from the XC course.

Registration:

Race entry fee is \$13 per race includes \$3 insurance surcharge. Registration opens at 11 am on Sat. and 8 am on Sun. and closes 15 minutes before each race. Riders must have a valid NCCA license. One day (\$10) and annual licenses (\$30) will be available for purchase on site.
