Rider certification is required in order to compete in any event. The CVC is a 166m track, with 50-degree banking. This is the steepest track in the USA, so you'll be in for a wild time if you haven't had a chance to get on it yet. Timed events will be open to any rider that passed the certification class and mass start events will be open to riders cat. 1-3 that have passed the certification class. Officials/track managers reserve the right to remove any rider from the course that is deemed unsafe. Helmets and USA cycling licenses required (1-day \$10), and all USAC rules do apply.

Fees: Certification class costs are covered by the promoters, but race fees of \$15/day will cover racers for as many races as they wish to enter.
